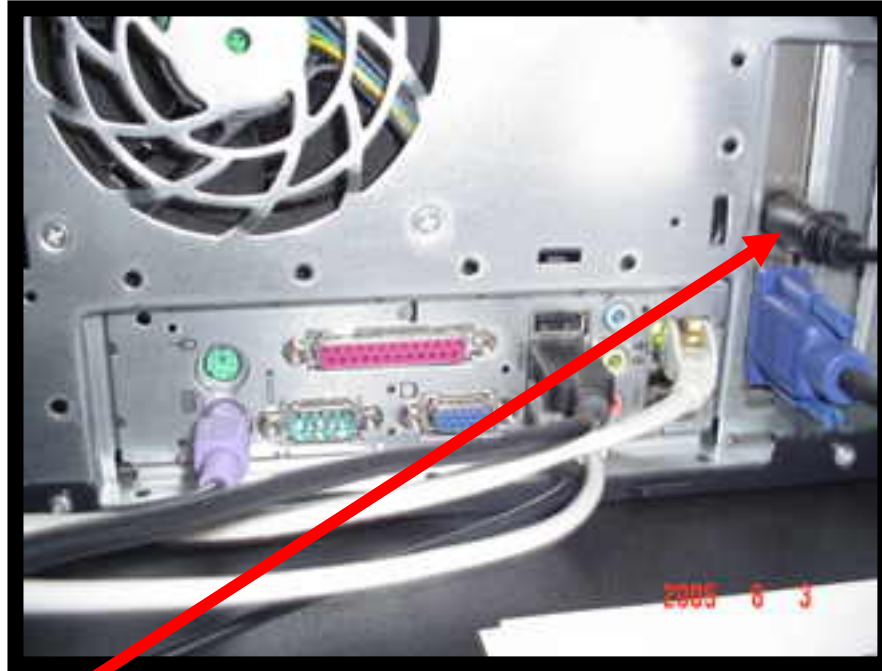








Back of a computer that has a built in scan converter



This is the jack that indicates that your new computer has a built in scan converter. It is right next to the port where the monitor plugs in. An S-video cable goes from this to the S-video connection in your TV.

All new computers that TPSS Technology Department buys will have the built in scan converter.

To make sure your computer screen image and your TV show a picture at the same time, follow these steps on your computer:

-  Right click on Desktop
-  Click Properties
-  Click the Settings tab
-  Click Advanced
-  Click the Display Tab
-  You will see a picture of a computer and a TV. The button at the top left hand corner of each picture should be green not red. The default seems to be that the computer button is green but the T. V. button is red. Once you click on the TV. button at the top left hand corner of the picture you should see a picture on both the TV and the computer screen at the same time.

Caution: When plugging in your S-video cable, be very careful not to bend the pins inside the plug... some teachers are experiencing problems as a result of bent pins.
