EAGLE

EAGLE (Enhanced Assessment of Grade-Level Expectations) online system is a valuable assessment tool designed for use by grades 3-12 classroom teachers. Thousands of items are currently available on this program.

All students have been uploaded into the program. Principals should have the school's password.

RESCORES

The final date for requesting rescoring for October testing is January 22.

LAA 2 REMINDER - GEE

LAA 2 students are now eligible for a high school diploma; therefore, if they are on a diploma track, they must achieve at least “Approaching Basic” on the GEE ELA and Math sections of the test and either Science or Social Studies.

SPECIAL EDUCATION WAIVERS

Students who have applied for special education waivers must NOT miss any of the opportunities to test.

LARGE PRINT

Schools were asked to request large print tests when submitting testing numbers. Schools should notify Paulette Walkwitz of students who are identified as needing large print between now and testing so that early orders can be placed.
